ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping Grand Prix Almaty 2013 Organizing Committee takes care of the full board accommodation for the athletes and officials.

The bookings for national teams-participants of FIS Ski jumping Summer Grand Prix are organized by the LOC according to the team quotas and sent entries.

For competitors and officials not included in the quota, the Organizing Committee provides full board accommodation with maximum prices:

SPORT CENTRE BAGANASHIL: 75 CHF /night/person.

ALMA-ATA HOTEL : 90 CHF /night/person

Full board accommodation costs for athletes-participants of FIS YOUTH CUP is covered by the Organiser.

All the bookings and accommodation request shall be sent directly to the LOC of Almaty address.

If there any NSA who has made its own accommodation arrangements is obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than **September, the 1st, 2013**

The LOC does not guarantee the availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than September, 1st, 2013.

However, if there are vacant rooms left at the LOC's disposal these will be provided to teams on request.

ARRIVAL

ALMATY International Airport, 20 km from the Ski Jumping Hills and the hotels, 30 minutes' drive





TRANSFERS AND TRANSPORTATION

Airport pick-ups will be provided on team's requests.

Shuttle bus services for teams and officials will be provided between the Hotels and Ski Jumping Hills / race- office (3 km) free of charge during the official training and competition days.

We kindly ask you to specify the date and the time of your departure so we can arrange inform the hotel on the individual check-out times and provide you with a transfer.

SKI WAXING AND SERVICE AREA

There will be limited ski-waxing rooms available at the hotels. Ski wax cabins will be located at the Ski Jumping Complex .

DOPING CONTROL

According to FIS Standards and Rules.

FIS LICENCE

To be eligible for participation in the FIS Summer GP all the skiers must have a valid FIS Code.

INSURANCE

All athletes need the insurance arranged by their National Ski Associations.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any injuries of the athletes neither for the damage or lost property.

LANGUAGE

The official language is English.

VISA INFORMATION

Citizens of Russia, the Ukraine, Belarus, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Uzbekistan and Moldova do not need visas to the Republic of Kazakhstan and can stay in the country up to 90 days with no further formalities.

ALL OTHER CITIZENS REQUIRE A VISA

- Please note that visa procedures may take **up to 3 weeks**.
- Make sure that you provide all the required documents in due time.
- The LOC of ALMATY will have a special visa arrangement with the Ministry of Home Affairs, and visas will **be received at the ALMATY Airport on arrival**.

List of required documents that need to be sent to the LOC official address as soon as possible (we strongly advice to send names and documents for all those who might be traveling to Almaty for the event as invitations are issued for each individual):

- **scan of a passport** (pages with personal details and photo) valid no less than 6 months ahead of your planned visit to Kazakhstan. The deadline for submission of passports (for all possible participants) : **August 31st, 2013**.
- if you have ever been to Kazakhstan before, please provide **scan of the page/pages** with entry & departure stamps from the immigration
- On receiving these, all team members will be provided with **registered invitation**, issued by the Ski Association of Kazakhstan. Each of you will receive two forms (one in Kazakh, one in Russian) that we ask you to print out and provide to the Consular Section on arrival to Almaty airport, **together with your passport** (no IDs accepted), **1 passport photo** (no older than 3 months), **consular fee** (preferably in cash in USD, otherwise in Euro) and **2 filled in forms** (one immigration registration form to be picked up and filled in at the airport on arrival, one application form).
- **Visa costs are 95 USD** per person and need to be paid cash on arrival at the Consular Section of the airport.

The immigration registration form picked-up, filled-in and stamped on arrival at the airport cannot in any circumstances be lost, and shall be presented to the immigration on departure.





Please note that receiving visa on arrival to the airport is not possible if all the above mentioned documents and criteria have not been provided and met.
