Absolut Park Rookie Fest will take place from 4th till 5th March 2021 and it will be a snowboard big air competition!

In the last 20 years, the Absolute Park has not only become the biggest snow park in Austria, but also one of the most famous in Europe. Don't miss the chance to compete there!

Due to Covid-19 Restrictions in Austria only Riders born from 2007 with active FIS-License are allowed to participate. For sure we will go back to our normal age categories as soon as the situation allows. This is as well a Europa Cup – which means as well adult riders are welcome.

ENTRY CRITERIA TO THE AUSTRIAN MASTERS BA - EC

- Riders, male and female, born 1st January 2003 till 2007 are admitted into the rookie fest.
- Riders will be divided in two age groups: born 2003 until 2005 (Rookies) 2006 and 2007 (Groms).
- As this year the event will be held as Europe Cup FIS License is necessary. Athletes licensed starting with 2007 and older are allowed to enter the event.
- To compete in EC Park & Pipe events a minimum of 10 FIS point for SS or BA (whichever are higher), or 50 WSPL points are required.

Rules:

The competition will be held under FIS Rules and regulations for Snowboard. This competition is a Snowboard Big Air Europe Cup and is open to both men and women. This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants. Covid-19 Precisions

Dear team captains. Please read through the following rules very carefully. These regulations are established by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health, Austrian Ski Federation and the LOC in cooperation with FIS. It is your responsibility to inform your entire team and make sure all members follow these rules without exceptions.

1. What is important:

- Take personal responsibility very serious
- hygiene measures at all times (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
- maintain a minimum distance of 2 meter in all areas (social distancing)
- wear FFP2 Masks at all times
 - on the entire event site, except
 - during the practice of sport
 - in the start area right before the start
 - inside all buildings
 - for all transports in buses, shuttles, gondolas, chair lifts
 - in the common areas of your accommodation

2. COVID-19 tests:

- Everybody (athletes, coaches and staff) who wants to get an accreditation for the event needs to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Antigen not older than 72 hours before the start of training). The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditations.
- Accreditation for persons with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection
 - present the PCR COVID-19 positive test result made between 2 weeks and 3 months before the arrival
 - free of COVID-19 symptoms for a minimum of 3 days before arrival
- 3. Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: https://forms.gle/LuRqfbLt41UBdTG5A
 - has to be filled out and sent online mandatory every morning before showing up at the bottom station of the gondola (will be controlled) Starting with the first day of training. Latest Wednesday morning the 03.03.2021
- 4. Team Captains Meeting (TCM): Online via Zoom Meeting. Will Follow
- **5.** Transportation rules for cars/team busses:
 - · max two people can be carried in each row of seats
 - wearing FFP2 mask is mandatory
- 6. Rules for Hotel/Accomodation:
 - professional athletes and coaches are allowed to stay in hotels, closed for the public
 - FFP2 mask mandatory, except at the table while meals
- 7. Transportation rules for gondola/chairlift:
 - checkpoint bottom station for the correct questionnaire by the COVID-19 Manager
 - FFP2 masks mandatory for gondola, possibility to get one at the bottom station
 - FFP2 mask for chairlift
 - half capacity at all times
 - staggered, team by team





















- Avoid crowds: inspection, toilets, gondola, chairlift
 - spend your free time only with members of your team in small groups
- 9. COVID-19 Communication
 - in case of COVID-19 symptoms immediately inform the COVID-19 Manager who is responsible for the Event – Markus Pfeiffenberger – info@die-essgalerie.at / +43 664 2129601
 - COVID-19 Manager activates the necessary COVID-19 measures all communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with LOC and FIS

NEW entry requirements for Austria

Dear all,

due to Covid-19 pandemic, new measures to contain the Covid-19 virus have been tightened. The regulation coming into force with Friday, 15.01.2021 means that entry into Austria is from that on only possible under the following conditions:

- From Friday, 15.01.2021 on all persons entering Austria are engaged to register through the "Pre-Travel-Clearance-Form" (also mandatory for children!).
- upon arrival registration has to be done online via the following https://www.formularservice.gv.at/site/fsrv/user/formular.aspx?pid=15dd7f9c98c24952828eb414c88 84f1a&pn=Bfd027cf662624276a5ca9a9b970bcdf9&lang=en
 - After your successful registration you will get a copy as well as a QR-Code. This serves as your backup for potential boarder-controls.
 - Furthermore a negative PCR or antigen Test (not older than 72 hours) is mandatory and also the attached certificate by a doctor needs to be uploaded via the online registration (see annex D "Medical certificate")
- When entering Austria from abroad, a guarantine of 10 days after entry is obligatory. This guarantine is not relevant if you are competing / working at
 - Worldcup or Europacup competitions in Austria with National Interest and if you have a copy of the letter from the Federal Ministry with you. This exception is only valid for registered participants as well as for anyone required behind the scenes for Worldcup and Europacup competitions.

- Summing up you what you need for you travel to Austria:
 - Online registration as described above upon arrival
 - o Invitation letter from the Austrian ministry (available through the LOC)
 - Confirmation, that you are professional Athlete (from your Ski Association)
 - Negative antigen / PCR Test not older than 72 hours certified by a doctor (see attached)

Data Protection to all Covid-measures:

The personal information provided is treated strictly confidentially by the Local Organizing Committee and Austrian Ski Federation (OESV). It will only be used for the purpose of assessing whether the applicant can be granted or maintain accreditation in view of the COVID-19 outbreak. In case the local and national public health department need your data we will provide them with all information. Otherwise all datas will be deleted after 28 days.
