4. Competition Rules

FIS Snowboard World Cup Rules (WCR) and International Competition rules (ICR) will be applied to this competition

5. Entries

Entries will be accepted from all National Ski & Snowboard Associations in accordance with FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be submitted through the FIS Online Registration System at the following address:

Entries submitted by mail or fax will not be accepted.

Provisional Entry Deadline: January 13th, 2020

Final Entry Deadline: February 12th, 2020

6. Participation Fee

According to the FIS Snowboard WC Rules, a mandatory participation fee of CHF 30 per each competitor and competition day has to be paid to the organizing committee. Participation Fee will be paid as Korean currency. (about KRW 35,000)

Payment must be made in credit card at the Race Office(Phoenix Pyeongchang The Hotel Room Agenda 1) before the competition.

7. Accreditation

Team Registration will take place daily starting on Wednesday 19th of February at the Race Office(Phoenix Pyeongchang The Hotel Room Agenda 1). Please refer the schedule availability of registration are as follows

Friday 21 ST of February	15:00 ~ 17:00

8. Accommodation

The OC will provide accommodation at the FIS rate of 80CHF or 96,000KRW per person/night, including breakfast and dinner for the **dates of the program only**. According to 'World Cup Rules Snowboard - 5.5 Duration', number of single and twin rooms will be provided. Extra single and twin rooms might cause extra charge. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate. All accommodation fees must be paid by credit card at the Race Office upon arrival. Only major credit cards will be accepted. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay and incidental charges (room service, laundry, etc.).

Please note that check-in and check-out dates must be **absolutely correct**. The OC must also be notified if no accommodation is needed. Reservations cannot be cancelled after the Provisional Entry Deadline (January 13th, 2020) and full room fees must also be paid in case of early departures or no-shows.

The OC will send a hotel booking confirmation to each team and team captain with the number of rooms and check-in/check-out dates. Please check the information carefully and in case any changes must be made after the online system closes, send requests by email to snowboard.kor@gmail.com

9. Transportation

If needed, the OC can arrange private transportation (car and driver) from Incheon International Airport to Phoenix Pyeongchang at the following rates:

- Luxury Sedan (up to 2 passengers): \$490 USD
- Starex Van (up to 5 passengers): \$440 USD
- Mini-Bus (6 ~ 12 passengers): \$500 USD
- Full-size Bus (more than 12 passengers): \$880 USD

*Rates quoted above are for one-way transfers only

*A \$20 USD surcharge will be applied for each piece of luggage

The OC will arrange for team members arriving within a similar timeframe to take the same vehicle unless otherwise requested.

The following information must be provided to the OC to properly arrange transfers:

- Total number of passengers (including team, staff and officials)
- Luggage details (quantity, weight, general size)
- Arrival/Departure dates and times
- Flight number and airport of origin

11. Training

Athletes may train on the Duke Slope located at left side of Phoenix Pyeongchang Ski resort. Date and Training time will be announced on the 1st TCM.

12. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Phoenix Pyeongchang Ski Resort, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event.

13. Insurance

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Phoenix Pyeongchang Ski Resort, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and 2nd or 3rd party claims before, during and after the event.

14. Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

15. Prize Money

Prize Money will be transferred within 7 days of the last day of competition directly to athletes' bank accounts in accordance with FIS WC Rules and Regulations. FIS Prize Money Bank Transfer forms must be completed and returned to the Race Office along with a passport copy in order to receive payment. Therefore, all top 10 placed athletes have to fill in the FIS Bank transfer Prize money form and hand it over in the Race Office together with a passport copy.
