Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art. 13)

Booking according the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system.

The OC offers accommodation (full board included) in 3* hotels (2* and 4* on request) in Val di Fiemme from 3 to 15 km from the stadium.

Three stars hotel max CHF 125 per person in double room,

Two stars hotel max CHF 90 per person in double room.

Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving preliminary entry and accommodation request.

Transport (World Cup Rules Art. 11)

Due to Covid-19 restriction the LOC is not able to organise any from/to foreign airports; the transfers. Therefore the official airports are: Venezia – Bergamo – Verona.

1 transport (from and to the airport) is free of charge. For the teams that need transport from the official airports to the hotels please contact: info@fiemmeworldcup.com

Price for additional transport (depending on destination) on request.

No shuttle service in the valley will be organised by the OC.

For the transportation service you must follow the national regulations.

The drivers are tested negative for Covid.19. Inside the cars/bus you must wear a surgical mask. The surgical mask must be put on before entering the vehicle.

Reimbursement (World Cup Rules Art. 10 and 13)

- Accommodation costs: Teams will pay directly in the hotel. The "Red Group" will be paid by the OC directly to the hotels.

Waxing facilities (World Cup Rules Art. 14)



- Wax cabins: available from: from 8:00 a.m. of Thursday 7th. January.
- For entering the athletes' zone (Frade) every person must exhibit the local accreditation.

In order to get the accreditation all teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS have to do the Covid-19 test, whose result must be negative.

A local laboratory will organise the testing service directly at the main entrance of the team area, starting from 7:00 a.m. on Thursday 7th. January 2021; the laboratory is evaluating the possibility to offer the testing service also on other days: Wednesday 6th. and on Saturday 9th. and Sunday 10th, for people travelling away from Val di Fiemme.

Details about time schedule will follow.

- You can get the keys of the cabins at the info point of the athletes' area.
- Parking cards will be delivered together with the accreditation.
- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks must inform the OC before 27/11/2020; the teams must inform the OC about size, power and special needs for the trucks. The trucks will be allowed to park inside the team area only starting from 8:00 a.m. of Thursday 7th. January.

For this reason, if you come earlier than 7th. January, you have to park the truck outside (in the parking on right side immediately after the bridge).

Please consider that also the drivers have to follow the same procedure like the team staff that is: to do a Covid-19 test, whose result must be negative.

- A local laboratory will organise the testing service directly at the main entrance of the team area, starting from 7:00 a.m. on Thursday 7th. January 2021; the laboratory is evaluating the possibility to offer the testing service also on other days: Wednesday 6th. and on Saturday 9th. and Sunday 10th.
- Details about time schedule will follow.
- SRS members coming with a waxing truck and requiring power supply will be charged CHF 100. The companies must communicate to the OC: info@fiemmemworldcup.com, the needs of their vehicle (size, power supply...) within 27/11/2020.
- Teams are responsible for a daily cleaning of their cabin. The LOC will supply every cabin with proper cleaning tools.
- A garbage drop-off point will be organised where the teams will have to leave all their garbage every day.

Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday- and night, other days with special regulations)

Team Catering

From Friday 8th. January to Sunday 10th. all people inside the team area will have a catering service at their disposal, free of charge, inside the building with the changing rooms near the info point.

The catering will be arranged as a take-away service according to the national current rules referred to food and beverage distribution. Everybody has to consume food and beverage exclusively inside their own changing room.

No lounge area with TV will be arranged.

A warm course (pasta or lasagne or soup) will be served from 11.30 to 14.30 from Thursday to Saturday.

We recommend every team to delegate not more than 2 persons for taking the lunch bags for all team members, in order to avoid people gathering.

Daily Buffet



The daily buffet will be served according to the national current rules referred to food and beverage distribution and only single dose products will be available:

Small sandwiches, fresh fruits with peel, biscuits, energy bars, chocolate, water bottles; hot tea and coffee served on request.

All changing room will be hygienized before the arrival of the teams, that will be responsible for the daily cleaning. The LOC will supply every cabin with proper cleaning tools.

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies:

The import and the operation of radio equipment in Italy is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications.

WARNINGS: Possibly send us the application form 15 days before the day you are going to use frequencies. Indicate an additional email address on the application form; All your communications shall include the identification number (for example ID: TEMP/year/nr) that the Ministry assigns you as soon as it receives your request.

Accreditation

The accreditation for teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS must be requested, like in the past season, through the FIS online system.

According to the FIS Covid-19 Prevention Protocol Guideline all accreditations will be released only as soon as the OC receives a negative Covid-19 test of all participants.

TEST: WHEN & WHERE

A Covid-19 test (rapid antigen test) must be done by all athletes, team staff, officials, SRS at the main entrance of the Team Area (Frade) at the Cross-Country Stadium in Lago di Tesero. The test can be done on Wednesday 6th January, starting from the afternoon, or on Thursday, 7th January 2021, starting from 7:00 a.m. according to the time schedule decided with FIS.

The laboratory which is in charge for the testing (Centro Medico Fiemme) will offer the testing service (only antigen test available) also on Friday 8th, Saturday 9th and Sunday 10th, according to the following timing: from 9.00 to 11.00 and from 15.00 to 17.00.

If you need a PCR test before leaving Val di Fiemme, there are two private laboratories that can do this kind of test, but you have to book it in advance:

PLEASE contact the OC with adequate notice in order to communicate your arrival time and let the OC know when you can be in Val di Fiemme to do the test, so that we can prepare a proper time schedule, in coordination with FIS, and avoid any kind of people gathering at the testing area. We will try to arrange the time schedule in order to give priority to the athletes. The laboratory "Centro Medico Fiemme" will ask all team members, before being tested, to fill in a form, where everybody will have to include their personal data and give to the laboratory and to the OC the authorisation to register the test results.

Please remember that the result of the rapid test must then be uploaded individually on the FIS Passport by all team members. Like for all other FIS competitions, please remember that you will be asked also to fill out the whereabouts and answer the health questionnaire on your FIS Passport.

In case of a positive result of the rapid test, please follow the procedures included in the specific point of this Protocol "FIS World Cup Communications flow for a Covid-19 positive test".

The positivity to the test does not allow to take part in the event, according to FIS rules. Please notice that in case of a positive result of a rapid test, a PCR test will be immediately required.

ADDITIONAL TEST FOR PEOPLE NOT COMING DIRECTLY FROM TOBLACH

Please notice that the LOC will ask all people that will come to Val di Fiemme directly from home and not from Toblach, and who consequently have not been part of the "Tour bubble" before the stages in Val di Fiemme, to present a negative PCR test that must be not older than 48 hours before the arrival at the competition venue. This test must be uploaded on your FIS Passport before arrival. Please consider that, according to the current Italian rules, also for entering Italy you need a negative PCR test not older than 48 hours before you cross the border.

All those people will then have to do also the rapid test at the entrance of the stadium, like everybody else, in order to get the accreditation. For any problem, please just contact the LOC: info@fiemmeworldcup.com.

TEST PAYMENT & ACCREDITATION RELEASE

Costs for testing are carried by the person or responsible group (i.e. Teams, FIS, Organiser for workforce, Stakeholders as groups and/or individual persons (i.e. journalists, etc.) The cost of the rapid test made at the cross country stadium is € 60,00 per person, that you can pay cash or with credit card.

Once we have the negative result of all team members, one team representative can pick up the accreditations, for all team members, at the accreditation office, inside the stadium. In order to enter the stadium and get the accreditation, the team representative can show to the LOC staff present at the access control, the confirmation email that he/she got from the LOC accreditation system after receiving the negative test.

Please note that due to Covid-19 restrictions and regulations, the current situation can change very quickly, therefore the LOC could be obliged to do some necessary adjustments or changes. In order to be always updated please consult our Covid-19 Prevention Protocol at the following link:

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

In order to ensure the FIS World Cup and an event is not placed at risk from a Covid-19 outbreak and consequences, it is the responsibility of every person to adhere to this policy, follow all procedures and instructions and behave in a disciplined manner at all times.

A breach of discipline protocol will lead to withdrawal of accreditation, such as going to locations with others present that are not subject to the protocol, i.e. bars, hotspots during the Event.

Referring to the FIS Covid-19 Prevention Protocol Guideline that provides that an athlete can take part in a World Cup and Tour de Ski event only after exhibiting a negative Covid-19 test (that must be not older than 72 hours before the arrival at the competition venue), we can inform you that the Laboratory "Centro Medico Fiemme", directly connected to the "Azienda Provinciale per i Servizi Sanitari", will arrange the testing service (rapid Covid-19 testing) to the teams starting from 7:00 a.m. on Thursday 7th. January 2021.

The laboratory which is in charge for the testing is evaluating the possibility to offer the testing service also on other days: Wednesday 6th. and on Saturday 9th. and Sunday 10th for people travelling away from Val di Fiemme.

The tests carried out with the drive-through procedure will be done in Lago di Tesero, in Via Lago, at the entrance of the team area.

Any other details regarding procedures, cost and timing of the tests will be communicated soon.

In case of a positive result of the rapid test, the positivity has to be confirmed following the National Health procedure.

The positivity to the test does not allow to take part in the event according to FIS rules.

General Information

PASS & PARK ALPE CERMIS

To reach the finish area of the Cermis Final Climb on Sunday 10th January, the Alpe Cermis cablecar cannot be used by the accredited people. One minibus per nation can get a parking card in order to go on Alpe Cermis and park there. For this particular season, the OC will allow the teams who will need it, to have another pass for a second vehicle: this further pass will be just a drop-off card, and it won't allow the parking at the finish area of Alpe Cermis.

BIBS DISTRIBUTION

The bibs for each competition will be delivered at the info point of the team area, in the morning.

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

All Team Captains' Meeting will be held online.

ALPE CERMIS

On Sunday one minibus per nation is allowed to park on Alpe Cermis. This year the LOC will allow one additional minibus per team, but this second minibus can just a drop-off vehicle.
