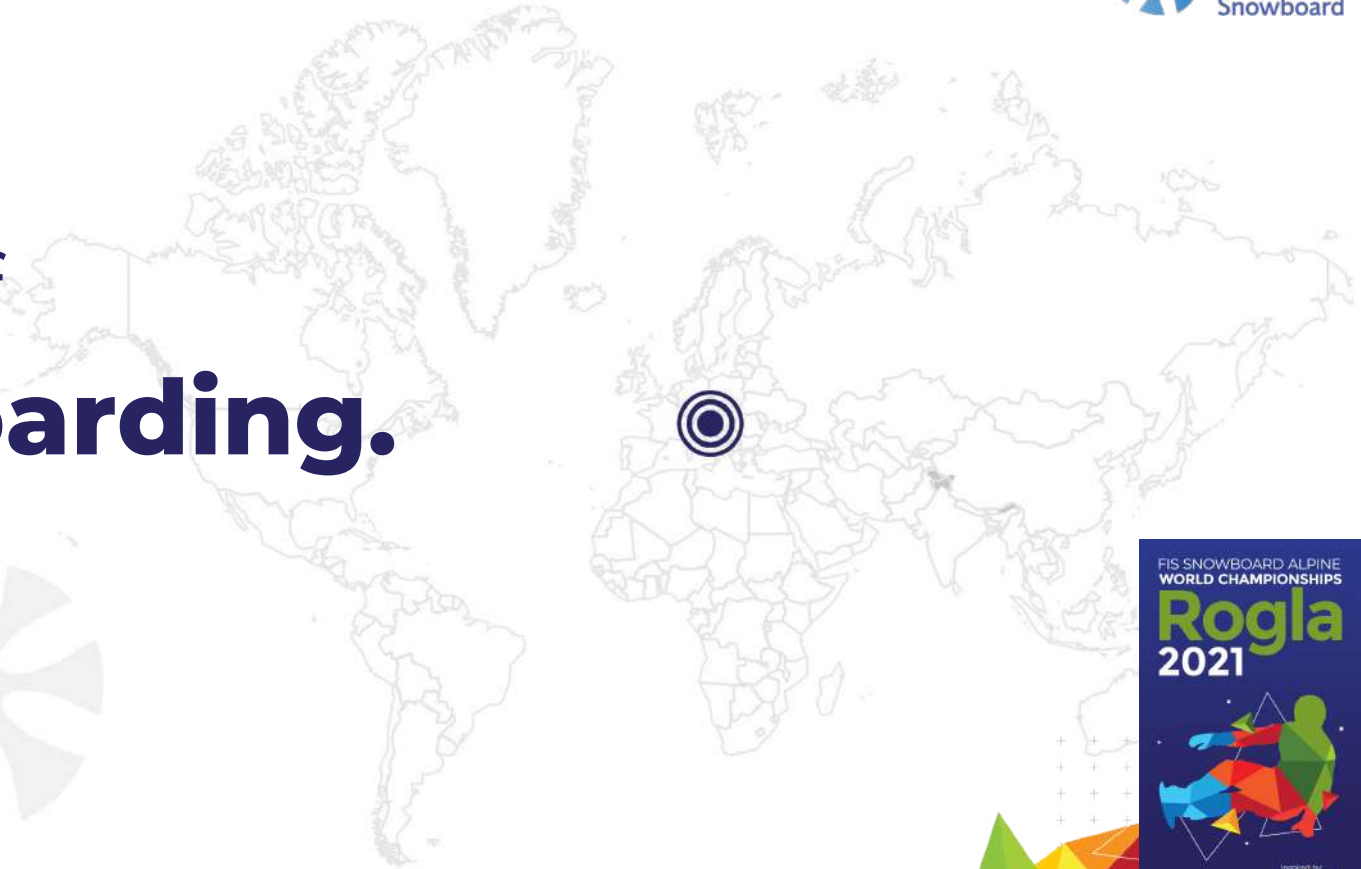


The **2021 FIS Snowboard Alpine World Championships** will take place on Rogla, Slovenia **March 1. - 2. 2021.**

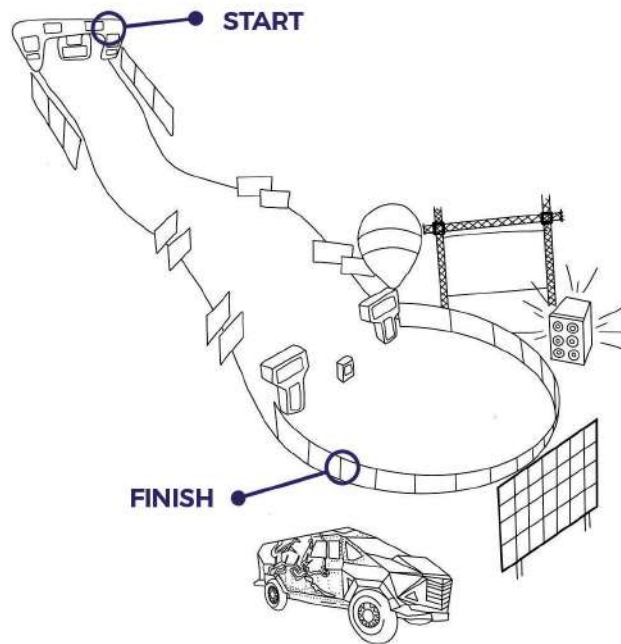

3. Athlete Qualifications



Athlete standards and Qualifications

For the Snowboard World Championships following additional regulations will apply:

- Basic Qualification (BQ): one competitor can be entered with a minimum of 5 FIS points in PAR.
- Additional Qualification (AQ): additional competitors need to have the minimum FIS point level as listed in the table below:

| Standard/Requirements | PAR |
|-----------------------|-----|
| BQ | 5 |
| AQ | 50 |



4. Entries and Participants, Team Personnel



FINAL ENTRIES: NOT LATER THAN 26TH FEBRUARY 2021

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski & Snowboard Associations, affiliated with the FIS in accordance with the FIS quotas and the rules for FIS World Championships.

4. Entries and Participants, Team Personnel

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

Maximum 4 competitors per nation per gender plus the competitors according to Art. 9.3.

TEAM PERSONNEL PER NATION (WSC Art. 9.4.3):

Number of officials

- up to 4 competitors: 3 coaches 2 physicians* 2 technicians/support staff

*Medical personnel includes physicians, physiotherapists, first aid people.

The quotas include the national team officials (team captains, etc.).

Each nation may register its President and Secretary General with the team entry for each of the disciplines.



5. Accommodations



- Teams (athletes and staff) will be placed in hotel Planja on Rogla based on their arrival/departure dates selected within the FIS entry submission.
- Accommodation payment must be made in full by departure day. Payments can be made by credit card, more details will be provided by the respective Lodging Coordinator.
- Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. All lodging accommodations are nonsmoking, NO EXCEPTION.

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.
