The French Ski Federation and the Organizing Committee of the AUDI FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP in Val Thorens are pleased to invite all Nations to attend this event from December 10th to 11th, 2021.

For your information, the reserve day is on the Sunday 12th.

1 / Program

You will find enclosed the provisional program of the event according to the FIS calendar. The OC reserves the right to modify this schedule, depending on the snow conditions or / and the decision of the competition jury.

Please note that the TCM will take place in the Meeting room of the “Maison de Val Thorens” on the 1st floor under the Club des Sports reception.

The first one will be on Monday the 6th at 06.00pm.

2 / Arrival

The appointment for the welcome, information and accommodation will be at the Sport’s Club Office at the « Maison de Val Thorens » on Monday 6th December 2021 between 02.00 and 06.00 pm.

Outside these hours, for all different questions regarding the organisation, please ask directly at the Club des Sports reception : Opening hours : 09.00 – 12.00 am & 02.00 – 05.00 pm

Each competitor and official will receive a 5 days SX stadium skipass and a wristban.

This wristband must be worn all the time and showed if required.

3 / Accommodation

Teams will be accommodated in several hotels or residences *** and more on half-board basis from Monday afternoon the 6th of December to Sunday 11th December afternoon (5 nights).

According to the FIS' rules, the OC takes over lunches of December 9/10/11th, directly on the SXWC' site as usual.

Other lunches are on teams' charge.

Each team will pay the total of the accommodation expenses at their arrival to the OC and a fully refundable breakage deposit will be required directly by the hotel or residence (major credit card only).

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini bar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes directly at the hotel.

The FIS' rate is CHF60 / day / pax.

The official single room FIS' quota is 3 single rooms per team and can be purchased at the rate of CHF100.

The OC will book maximum 3 single rooms per team, no more.

Please, fill in your accommodation needs on the FIS Online Entry System (Team size) with a provisional completed rooming list with any requirements about rooms & place sharing before **October 30th, 2021**.

4/ ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The final entries of your competition team (competitors, officials, and other staff) with your arrival and departure dates (Names, FIS code for the participants and Gender) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **November 29th 2021**.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the organizing committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or persons who register late have no right to reservation at the FIS rate.

5/ BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition and awards ceremony after the competition.

6/ PRIZE MONEY & PRIZE MONEY TAXES

Please note that the prize money will be transferred to the athletes' account.

NSAs are responsible for entering the personal bank information for each athlete using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section. A withholding French tax (15%) will be retained on the prize money.

7/ INSURANCE - LIABILITY

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee sponsors, suppliers, their agents, FIS and the French National Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment during the event.

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The OC, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

8/ COVID INFORMATIONS

According to the French law, a health pass (Sanitary Pass) is put in place in all the french territory. It is mandatory to access places of leisure, sports and culture. Since 9 August 2021, it is also mandatory in cafes, bars, restaurants ...

Sanitary pass is necessary to acces any sporting or festive event, organised in the public space or in a place open to the public, which may give rise to a control of the access of persons as the SXWC.

What is the sanitary pass :

- The vaccination certificate, provided that persons have a complete vaccination plan:
 - 7 days after 2nd injection for dual injection vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca);
 - 28 days after injection for single injection vaccines (Janssen/Johnson & Johnson);
 - 7 days after injection of the vaccine in people who had Covid-19 (only 1 injection).
- Proof of negative RT-PCR, antigenic or self performed under the supervision of a health professional of less than 72 hours maximum.
- The result of a positive RT-PCR or antigenic test attesting to the recovery of Covid, dating from at least 11 days and less than 6 months. It indicates a limited risk of reinfection with Covid-19.

For now, the french government only recognizes « Pfizer » - « Moderna » - « Astrazeneca » ans « Johnson&Johnson ».
