10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

IMPORTANT COVID 19 RULES

The FFP2 mask requirement applies in the Start and Finish are, in all closed rooms, public transport, in the queuing areas, on the lifts, in the gondolas and outdoors wherever the minimum distance of 2 meters cannot be maintained.

The races will be closed to spectators – just participating athletes and responsible team coaches are allowed to stay at the event facilities.

All athletes and coaches must complete the registration and health questionnaire daily.
