

COVID-19 Protocol and Actions during FIS SJ World Cup Wisła 2021

GENERAL – LOC and Polish Regulation

Current situation in Poland is stable. Local health authorities are addressing the following information:

- # Use protection mask in all closed public areas and in the open space where you can't keep at least 1.5m distance from others
- # Clean hands and use hygienic liquids
- # Keep social distance min.1,5m

ARRIVAL TO POLAND

No quarantine after presenting the UE C-19 vaccination certificate or recovery certificate or negative C-19 result no earlier than 48h. LOC can provide test from private company paid by team/NSA on their request.

During planning travel to Poland keep in mind restrictions in other country on your way.

RESTRICTIONS IN MOVING AROUND

Minimum distance between people who are not living together is 1.5m

Face covering (mouth and nose) is mandatory in public areas like shops, petrol station, public transportation and hotel. No need of face covering (mouth and nose) in the open space or private car where the distance min.1.5m can be kept.

HOTEL – all teams and officials accommodated in Gołębiewski Hotel

All teams and officials accommodated in Hotel Gołębiewski by LOC will be placed on the same floors – we recommend to use stairs and avoid risk in the lift.

Wear protection mask in public areas like lift, halls, restaurant buffet

- # floors dedicated for FIS reservations
- # Dedicated meals area – separated room '02' on the 1st floor beginning from dinner on 2nd December
- # meal buffet will be prepared in dedicated area, gloves will be provided to take the food
- # water in bottles
- # dedicated check-in area at the front desk in the Hotel. Team' Captain or representatives can do check-in for all team while others are waiting in the front of the hotel or in the cars.
- # Isolation room booked in the hotel – in case of any symptoms immediately separation of suspects.

TRAVEL FROM HOTEL TO VENUE AND BACK

- # Use own vehicles
- # Do not stop until the park area in the venue/at the hotel
- # Parking area for teams and officials will be located closed to the athlete area. All team's car passes are allowed to enter the venue to unload and pick up the equipment.

VENUE

- # Use direct access from parking area to athletes' compound
- # Athletes' compound will be fenced (no contact with external people). Access to the area from Wisla direction only with accreditations and by cars with permissions.
- # Only packed food in the catering area
- # Mandatory use of mask in situation where 1,5m distance can't be kept (waiting room at the start, coach platform)
- # Use of lift limited to 1 person

WARM ROOM AT START

- # Additional space at start tower : waiting room in cafeteria and on the way to start.
- # Limited number of athletes in the permanent waiting room
- # Only single use drinks and snacks
- # Volunteer will deliver the bags from waiting area to the lift for way back to the athlete area.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL AT START

- # Equipment controller and LOC helpers wear mask

COACH PLATFORM

Coaches must wear mask and keep social distance in coach platform

EXIT GATE

Keep social distance

No Team Staff is allowed to stay (only to leave the bags)

Only Team Staff will deliver athletes' bag – local volunteers will be used only at the team's request.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL AT EXIT GATE

Only equipment controller + 1 assistant + 1 athlete are allowed to enter in the equipment area

MIXED ZONE

TV/Radio/Press at social distance

Media people wear mask

TCM

TCM (Pdf version) PPT Presentation for Teams

TCM will be held in a meeting room with one member per team and social distance in the room.

COVID-19 ACTION

Isolation room will be prepared in the hotel and at the hill. If any symptom of illness will be noticed immediately separation of suspect will be done. Next steps will be taken under consideration based on information from Medical and Hygiene Authority.

One prepared Ambulance will be used in case of need of transportation for suspect.

All actions needs to be taken in case of suspect will be discuss and decided between LOC Medical Advisor and FIS Officials.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL – BASED ON FIS REGULATIONS

BEFORE ARRIVAL

Every person who wishes to access a FIS World Cup Event must have and present a negative Covid-19 RT-PCR Test result (saliva/swab test) carried out at least 72 hours prior to arrival/accreditation, uploaded to the FIS Passport as soon as the result is available (for the LOC to check your status) and complete a Health Questionnaire (see Annex 1 as example). Pre-testing requirement is mandatory for all accredited individuals regardless to immunity and vaccination status.

ON SITE TESTING

In addition to pre-entry testing, an on-site testing in case of symptoms and testing after day 2/3 for non-vaccinated and non-previously infected persons

Covid19 vaccinated (valid vaccination status) and Covid19 previously infected persons do not need to undergo on-site testing after providing the initial PCR test upon arrival.

Please be advised that NEGATIVE PCR Test is required. The fully vaccinated people as well need to present NEGATIVE PCR Test.

Protection mask need to be used all the time : no need only during warm up – keep the distance – and right before the start after passing the equipment control box

All statement regarding COVID-19 situation needs to be approved by FIS Officials and LOC.
