Responsibility :The participants have to prove insurance for accidents. The organizer takes neither responsibility in case of accidents and the consequences for third party risks.

Accommodation is only provided according to the nation quota. Accommodation reservation must be made by January 11th 2022.

For room reservations cancelled after the registration deadline, a cancellation fee of 100% of the costs incurred must be paid by the National Ski Association. The teams will be accommodated in hotels booked by the organizer after they have registered. The hotels must present to the organizer a hygiene concept approved by the health authority. Mainly single rooms or double rooms with separate beds will be provided. In addition, each hotel has to provide two isolation rooms for suspected COVID-19 cases and people who have been tested positive

Also fully vaccinated and/or previously infected people have to present a proof of a negative PCR test. Team accreditations must be collected by one representative of the team. Access to the accreditation office takes place individually. Wearing a mouth-nose cover in the accreditation office is mandatory.

## NOTES ON INFECTION PROTECTION MEASURES

- Access to the competition venue is cordoned off and controlled.
- Only accredited persons are allowed access.
- Persons with symptoms of infection are not allowed to enter the venue.
- Only athletes and staff, officials, judges and volunteers, whose personal data are recorded, are accredited. Without accreditation, it is forbidden to enter the venues
- Spectators are limited allowed.

## GENERAL HYGIENE RULES / MOUTH AND NOS PROTECTION

- Compliance with hygiene measures (hand disinfection, coughing and sneezing hygiene, minimum distance of 1.5m) must be observed. Dispensers with disinfectants for hand-disinfection are provided. The signs of the organizer at the competition venues must be observed.
- Wearing a mouth-nose-cover on the event venue is mandatory. (except for athletes for ski jumping part: mouth-nose-cover is required until the control of crotch and after leaving the exit gate - for cross country part mouth-nose-cover is required until entering the starting area and from leaving the finish area)
- Entering the race office is only permitted for employees of race office, members of competition management (including Race Secretary) and one person per Ski Association. Wearing a mouth-nose-cover is also required here.
- Only members of the competition management, jury members (including race secretary), judges, employees of the data service are allowed to stay in the judges' tower. When staying in the judges' tower, wearing a mouth-nose-cover is required
- For the coaches wearing a mouth-nose-cover is required at the coaching stand! The number of coaches who are allowed to stay at the coaches' stand is limited according to the compliance with the minimum distance.
- In the starting area of the hill, accumulations are to be avoided! Only a certain number of athletes in the starting area is allowed
- The start and finish area for the cross-country competition is cordoned off. Access is controlled. Only athletes with a starting bib and persons identified as judges are allowed to enter. For the judges in the start and finish area wearing a mouth-nose-cover is required.
- Wearing a mouth-nose-cover is required for the victory ceremony. The minimum distance must be observed!
