Logistical information

Accommodation

The OC offers modern and stylish accommodation in the centre of Tallinn [IBIS Tallinn Center](#) (full board included):

- The OC will cover accommodation costs according to the FIS World Cup rules
- Each team has the right (for each gender) to have one single room without any additional cost. All other single rooms will be charged.

The price for accommodation outside of the red croup/COC winners or for additional nights is CHF 125 per person in double room.

The price for additional single rooms is CHF 160.

Teams and SRS companies must use the FIS competition online entry system for accommodation reservation according to FIS World Cup rules Art. 5.1.1

Accreditation

Accreditation can be picked-up at the Race office from March 19th.

Transport

Transport between airport and hotel (World Cup Rules Art. 5.2)

Official airport: Tallinn Airport.

The OC will arrange transportation between the airport and the hotels. One free of charge transfer per team from the official airport to hotel and one from the hotel to the airport. Booking through FIS online registration system.

Transport between hotels and venue

The OC will provide a shuttle service between hotel and the venue.

Reimbursement

Expenses sheets will be received by email: ave@suusaliit.ee or in the financial office during the race days.

Payments will be done by bank transfer.

Travel money and Nation support

The bank transfer form for team reimbursement/prize money is available on FIS website and has to be filled out electronically in advance and sent to ave@suusaliit.ee. Please note that the prize money, nation support and travel money is in the same form.

Prize money

Prize money payment (Word Cup Rules Art. 3.5) OC will use a protected FIS database for prize money payment information. Please make sure that all your athletes' information is uploaded to the system before the race weekend (including Tax codes).

Estonian law does not allow any prize money transfer without indicating the TINs (Tax identification number). You can find an instruction where to find your personal TIN here:
