My professional team is doing everything possible to make this event the most memorable for all of you. Now the spotlight will be on your performance.






# PLANICA 2023 ORGANISATIONAL CHART






# PLANICA 2023 ORGANISATIONAL CHART CROSS-COUNTRY







Medal Plaza will be located in Kranjska Gora, between Hotel Kompas and Hotel Ramada Resort.







## ACCOMMODATION

The National Ski Association (NSA) teams/athletes will be accommodated in hotels of a very good standard in and around Tarvisio (ITA) and Villach / Faaker See Region (AUT), within a 35 km driving radius from the venue. The decision to accommodate teams in co-host cities in Italy and Austria is due to the idea of cross border cooperation and to avoid spectators flows to the Planica Valley.

The Official Incoming Office and the LOC have a good relationship with the hotels and can assure accommodation especially adjusted to the needs of the athletes and teams. The hotels are adapted to the needs of athletes, especially with regards to the selection of food and mealtimes at the hotel. Three meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) per day will be served at the hotel (in case nothing else is agreed). The Official Incoming Office will manage the booking of accommodation on a first come first served basics.

As soon as the Official Incoming Office (Official WSC Reservation Office) has received the requests for accommodation via the FIS online entry system, a detailed offer will be sent to the NSA.

The LOC will cover the costs of accommodation for qualified athletes according to the rules and the applicable quota (art. 17.7). The Official Incoming Office is happy to organise the stay for all athletes/officials before and after the official Championships period (21st Feb. – 5th March). Please request an individual offer.

## **Deadline for Preliminary Entry**

By 31st October 2022 the number of double and single rooms required, and arrival/departure dates must be communicated using the FIS online entry system. Please note that the LOC cannot guarantee rooms or prices after this date. As soon as the LOC has received the preliminary entry the NSA will receive the details and feedback about the designated hotel.

#### **Payment**

An invoice for the deposit of 50% of the cost of the total number of rooms and nights will be sent to each NSA, for payment to be done no later than **7**<sup>th</sup> **November 2022**. An invoice of the remaining 50% will be sent for payment to be done no later than **31**<sup>st</sup> **January 2023**. If payment is not received before the due date, the LOC reserves the right to cancel the reservation.

After the event reimbursement of the expenses will be prepared according to the rules for free accommodation for qualified competitors and will be paid as soon as possible but not later than 1st April 2023.

#### **Cancellation conditions**

Cancellation must be made via the FIS online entry system.



Cancellation may be done without charge, in case of:

- Cancellation of up to 100% of the original reservation is received before 31st October 2022.
- Cancellation of up to 50% of the original reservation is received before 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022.
- Cancellation of up to 20% of the original reservation is received before 31st January 2023.

Booking details received by **31**st **January 2023** will be considered as final and will be the basics for calculating the total payment, cancellation fees and charges for no-shows. In case of no-shows there will be no refund (100% of the booked reservation has to be paid). If a cancellation is received later than the above-mentioned dates, the NSA has to pay 100% of the reservation.

## TRANSPORTATION

Free transport will be provided to the teams from the following airports: Ljubljana, Klagenfurt, Venice, Trieste and Zagreb to their accommodation upon requests. The free service includes one trip per team per discipline in each direction. Transportation services from and/or to other airports listed below can also be provided by the LOC. Such services will be charged by invoice. Please request an individual offer.

Transportation requests must be submitted through the FIS online entry form not later than 31st January 2023 and should include number of passengers as well as number of baggage items (bags, SJ and CC ski bags). All teams arriving with their own means of transport should indicate so in the FIS online entry form. Any changes to transportation requests must also be done through the FIS online entry form. Any last notice changes should additionally be reported to Planica 2023 Transportation Office via email transportation.planica@sloski.si.

## Transportation service during the event

The LOC will provide a shuttle service free of charge between Planica venue and the OC official team hotels in Tarvisio (ITA) and Villach/Faaker See Region (AUT).

From independently booked hotels/pensions/B&B's the transportation to the venue and back will be provided only for an extra cost. An intention to use such transport possibility have to be send to Planica 2023 Transportation Office via email <a href="mailto:transportation.planica@sloski.si">transportation.planica@sloski.si</a> not later than 31st January 2023. Daily transports should be announced 24 hours prior to the needs. Price per person and technical details TBD.

#### **Parking**

Parking is limited at the venue in Planica. Only one car/van per team per discipline is allowed to park directly at the SJ and CC team areas.

Access with other vehicles will be possible to the team drop off point at the venue. Afterwards the vehicles must park at the nearest parking lots outside the venue which will be clearly marked. The shuttle service from there to Planica venue will be provided.

Exact information about the drop off point and the location of parking outside of the venue will be provided at the later stage.



Parking permits will be prepared at the Accreditation Office. Please make a note in your entry, how many vehicles per disciplines needs to have access to the team drop off point at the venue. After checking the needs against capacity, the LOC will confirm the allocation of parking spaces.

## PRELIMINARY ENTRY FOR TEAMS AND SRS INDUSTRY

To submit the preliminary entry for the FIS Nordic World Ski Championships 2023 in Planica for NSA and SRS Industry, please use the FIS online entry system where you will complete your preliminary entry, including accommodation and transportation requests.

The system is open from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. The deadline for the preliminary entry including all information about accommodation, wax cabins and wax trucks is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.

## Provisional team selection

According to art. 13.3.1 of the World Championships rules the entry of the registered competitors with a valid FIS license by name, with the preliminary number of participants in each single event must be made online not later than 31st January 2023.

#### Final team selection

The final team selection must be done online not later than 24 hours after the last FIS World Cup before the respective Championships (art. 13.3.3).

## **Assistance**

The teams that compete at the World Cup competitions may use their existing login details for the FIS online registration system. If your NSA does not have a login yet, please contact FIS responsible person Mrs. Josephine Aschhoff at <a href="mailto:aschhoff@fisski.com">aschhoff@fisski.com</a> to apply one.

Please note that Mrs. Aschhoff is only responsible to give you the login and not for the registration itself.

### SRS Industry

Member companies of SRS need to register via the FIS online system. In cooperation with SRS – Mr. Riccardo Zanoni – the LOC will confirm wax cabins as well as parking spaces.

# WAX CABINS AND WAX TRUCKS FOR TEAMS AND SRS INDUSTRY

## **Cross-Country team area**

The wax cabins will be allocated based on the number of participants in each discipline per nation. The LOC together with the FIS will make the final allocation after receipt of the preliminary entries. Wax cabins must be registered by 31st October 2022.

The CC team area and CC courses will be open from 17th February 2023 for training.



## Nordic Combined / Ski Jumping team area

The wax cabins will be allocated based on the number of participants in each discipline per nation. The LOC together with the FIS will make the final allocation after receipt of the preliminary entries.

The basic criteria are: Max number of cabins per NSA: 4 - Every NSA is allowed to request extra cabins (max. 2)

All wax cabins are located at the Ski Jumping team area.

Please be aware that all wax trucks will be located at the Cross-Country wax area.

Waxing cabins must be registered by 31st October 2022.

## **Service Industry**

The LOC offers wax cabins for SRS in Cross Country wax area.

Invoices must be paid until: 1st December 2022.

## **WAX TRUCKS**

At the Planica venue one (1) wax vehicle/truck per team with maximum dimension 20 x 10 m (when extended) will have permission to park. Team needs to register their wax vehicle/truck with the preliminary entry by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022. All wax vehicle/trucks will be located at the Cross-Country wax area. Teams arriving with wax trucks are not entitled to a wax cabin.

**Attention**: Trucks are not allowed to drive during Sundays and public holidays in Slovenia. For driving on Sunday, the special permit by Slovenian authorities is needed. # REGULATIONS OF RADIO EQUIPMENT / RADIO FREQUENCIES

Please note that radio equipment may only be used with the permission (licence) of the Agency for communication networks and services of the Republic of Slovenia (AKOS) and/or according to the Radio Equipment Directive (RED - 2014/53/EU) - general authorisation (harmonized usage in EU).

Anyone planning to use radio frequency equipment in Slovenia needs to fill out a form (or forms) in order to apply for a permit. You can find the forms on following links:

The deadline for frequency applications for the FIS Nordic World Ski Championships Planica 2023 is 42 days before the event which is **9**<sup>th</sup> **January 2023**.

All radio equipment must have a CE mark (that it can be used in EU) according to the Radio Equipment Directive (RED - 2014/53/EU).

It is not allowed to set up and use private Wi-Fi networks or similar and/or other devices operating in the 2.4 and 5 GHz frequency bands within the venue in Planica.

## ACCREDITATION AND RACE OFFICES

The Accreditation Office will be located on the way between Kranjska Gora and Planica, near village Podkoren. Exact location TBC.

## PRELIMINARY ENTRY FOR TEAMS AND SRS INDUSTRY

The accreditation system will be operational in November 2022.

To submit the preliminary entry for the FIS Nordic World Ski Championships 2023 in Planica for NSA and SRS Industry, you will have to use our accreditation system, because only through this system accreditations for the Championships can be applied for.

NSA team leaders and SRS industry representatives will receive an URL, where they will have to register, afterwards they will be able to manage the whole team. The URL will be forwarded via email by the OC Planica.

This procedure is mandatory and is the prerequisite for accrediting the entire team. Mandatory information for each team member is their first and last name, a current photo on which the face is visible, date of birth and their function.

## **Race Offices**

The Cross-Country Race Office will be located at the Cross-Country Stadium, next to the Team Area in lower floor of the Stadium building.

The Nordic Combined Main Race Office and the Ski Jumping Race Office will be in Ski Jumping Team Area.

## **Medical Meeting**

The Medical Meeting will take place **on Tuesday**, **21**<sup>st</sup> **February 2023 at 15:00** in front of the Kavka building, building next to the Ski Flying Hill.

#### Insurance

All participants need to have a valid accident and health insurance. The LOC will not be liable for accidents of participants and officials.

## PRIZE MONEY

In case a member of your team receives any prize money, we will download the required information from the FIS database. Please make sure that all the information is updated.

The income tax of non-Slovenian citizens is currently 10,5%. This tax will be directly reduced from the prize money and forwarded from the OC directly to the Slovenian tax authority. There is no possibility for a cash payment.

## COVID-19

So far there are no specific limitations to conduct major sports events in the Republic of Slovenia. In case of pandemic or any other health situation LOC will follow national legislation and the rules/guidelines of the International Ski and Snowboard Federation. If FIS Anti-Covid protocol will apply, LOC will respect it.

I case of new pandemic and potential new restrictions regarding the travelling crossborder OC will use all their efforts to assure smooth daily migration between accommodation sites and competition venue in Planica. If European Union and/or national legislation of other countries will not allow crossborder travelling, OC will inform competition teams accordingly. Worst case scenario will be activated in coordination with FIS.

## SUMMARY OF FIS RULES

## 8. Eligibility and Citizenship of the Competitors

To be eligible for entry in FIS World Championships the competitor must be citizen of the nation of which National Ski Association he has a licence and prove this with a valid passport (ICR 203).

### 8.1 Age Groups

The age groups eligible for entry are defined in the respective discipline International Competition Rules (ICR). The FIS competition year is July 1st-June 30th of the following year. In order to compete, a competitor must have reached his birthday before the end of the calendar year (January 1<sup>st</sup>- December 31<sup>st</sup>) in question. The right to compete starts at the beginning of the competition year (July 1<sup>st</sup>) even if the competitor has not yet reached his birthday at that time.

### 9. Number of Participants and Officials

- 9.1 The maximum number of participants from each nation and the qualification levels shall be:
  - 9.1.1 Nordic events Cross-Country, Ski Jumping, Nordic Combined

#### 9.1.1.1 Cross-Country

12 men, 12 women, plus the competitors according to art. 9.3. To be eligible for entry in FIS World Championships the cross-country competitors must have fewer than 700 FIS points in the last FIS points list (distance or sprint) as published before the deadline for the provisional team selection.



Competitors who have reached at least one result better than or equal to 90 FIS points distance for the men and 120 FIS points distance for the women during the last 365 days, will be allowed to start in the distance competitions (Interval Start, Skiathlon and Mass Start).

A qualification competition will be scheduled for the athletes who did not reach these requirements. The athletes who have reached the above requirements are not allowed to start in the qualification race. The top 10 ranked competitors will be allowed to start in the Interval Start competitions as part of their nation's quota.

The top 10 ranked competitors will be allowed to start in the Skiathlon and Mass Start competitions as part of their nation's quota under the condition that they have less than 180 FIS Distance points for the Women and 140 FIS Distance points for the men in the current FIS Distance points list.

#### 9.1.1.2 Ski Jumping

Men 6 competitors, Women 5 competitors plus the competitors according to art. 9.3.

#### 9.1.1.3 Nordic Combined

Men 6 competitors, Women 5 competitors plus the competitors according to art. 9.3.

#### 9.2 Number of participants in each single event

In each single event no more than 4 competitors per National Ski Association plus the competitors according to art. 9.3, are entitled to start.

## 9.2.1 Official Training Ski Jumping, Nordic Combined and Ski Flying

A maximum number of 6 athletes (Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined Women 5 athletes) may take part in the official training plus competitors according to art. 9.3.

- **9.3** The reigning FIS World Champion/s has/have the right to participate at the next FIS World Championships in the event/s they won, in addition to the team quota, under the condition they are entered by the same National Association (this is valid only for the individual competitions and not for the team competitions). If however the World Champion/s is/are also entered for other events, they must be included within the overall team quota.
- 9.4 The maximum number of team officials, medical and technical personnel per national team shall be:
  - **9.4.1 FIS Nordic World Ski Championships Number of officials per discipline and gender:** Cross-Country Women, Cross-Country Men, Ski Jumping Women, Ski Jumping Men, Nordic Combined Women, Nordic Combined Men = number of athlete(s) + 2 Team Officials (maximum number of participants according to art. 9.1.1.1 9.1.1.1.3)

#### 13.2 Preliminary team entry for each nation

The entry is made using the FIS online entry system stating the preliminary total number of the national team competitors, also giving details of the number of officials and the approximate number of competitors in each of the following groups of events. The due date is three months before the FIS World Championships takes place:

13.2.1 Nordic Events: Cross-Country, Ski Jumping, Ski Jumping Mixed Team, Nordic Combined.

#### 13.3 Team Selection

### 13.3.1 Provisional Team Selection

21 days before the beginning of the competitions or the Opening Ceremony. Entry of the registered competitors with a valid FIS licence by name, with the preliminary number of participants in each single event defined in art. 13.2.

## 13.3.3 Final Team Selection

The final team selection by name and event with numbers according to art. 9 are to be made at latest 24 hours after the final World Cup event preceding the respective FIS World Championships.

### 13.4 Time-limit for definite entries

Definite entries per event, stating names and group classification of competitors according to the International Competition Rules.

## 14. Anti-Doping and Medical Rules

- 14.1 If any question or protest arises as to the gender of the athlete, FIS shall assume responsibility for taking the necessary steps to determine the gender of the athlete (ICR art. 221.4).
- 14.2 Anti-Doping control of all events is compulsory.
- 14.4 The FIS Anti-Doping Rules compiled in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code define all by-laws concerning anti-doping controls.



## 17.5 Accommodation and Meals

17.5.1 At FIS World Championships in the Alpine and Nordic disciplines the maximum price per person (non-qualified athletes, team officials, President and Secretary General according to the quotas in 9.4.1, 9.4.2 and 9.4.4) for accommodation and three meals including non-alcoholic drinks with each meal may not exceed CHF 120 per day.

17.5.2 For extra team officials and special guests, according to the quotas defined in art. 9.4.7 and 9.4.8, that are officially entered and whose accommodation has been reserved through the LOC, the maximum price for accommodation with half board shall not exceed the maximum price at the same period the previous year in the same accommodation (plus/minus inflation), but in any case not exceed CHF 200.













