2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and the Megève Committee are organising international FIS and Europa Cup Single and Dual Moguls competitions, part of the 2024 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- These competitions are **Single and Dual Moguls events** for both men and women.
- These competitions will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, number of competitors or the decision of the competition jury.



3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National Ski Associations in accordance with the official FIS Entry Form within the FIS quotas for EC 2.2.2

The entries for this event must be done on the FIS On line Entry system (Member section) before February 25th, 2024

6. Lift tickets and Bibs

The lift tickets and trainings bibs per nation can be picked up at the organizing center at the TC meeting. An invoice for the Entry Fee per nation will be delivered.

All competitors must wear their bibs during the trainings and competitions.

Competitions bibs can be picked up in the morning at the bottom of the chairlift.

Each Nations Team Captain will be responsible to return the bibs to the official at the end of the competition in the finish area before the prize giving ceremony.

Missing bibs will be charged with 50 € per bib.

9. Bibs, Helmets and Liability

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 20 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, Megève Sports Club, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participant are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

10. Accident Insurance & Protocol

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, Megève, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
