The event is sanctioned by FIS and Freestyle Canada and part of the NORAM Cup. ***This year, we are celebrating the 12th year anniversary of the Stepuptour and it will happen directly after the Stoneham World Cup on the same Slopestyle course.***

1. The event is sanctioned by FIS and Freestyle Canada, and is organized by Stepuptour 2026 in collaboration with La Station Touristique Stoneham. The event will operate according to the following rules and guidelines:

LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of training and competition at registration office. There are two options for lift tickets: 1) single day for 55\$ Cad/day + GST 2) 6 days package lift ticket for 300\$ cad from Feb 2nd – 7th. There are no refunds with either option. To qualify for this competition pricing, athletes must appear on the registration list. Each competitor must have a valid lift ticket or an access card to the venues for each day of the event.

Please note that we accept credit card and wire transfers.

Coaches and officials: Free LIFT TICKET and available at race office.

ACCESS CARD TO THE VENUES (mandatory XLparkpass): this access card is included for those who will purchase lift ticket at the registration office. A fee of 60\$CAD will be charge for any participants who doesn't need lift ticket. **Please note that we accept credit card and wire transfers.**

BIB DEPOSIT

There will be a **\$40 CASH ONLY** bib deposit. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be a **\$40 replacement fee**. An athlete's bib number must match event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.

SLOPESTYLE, BIG AIR & RAIL JAM HEAT FORMAT

Ski Slopestyle will consist of best of 2 runs qualification and a best of 2 runs final.

Ski Big Air will consist of best of 2 runs qualification and a 3 runs final, A-B FORMAT.

Ski Railjam will consist of best 4 runs out of 8 qualification and Head to head final format

*subject to change

The jury can determine the format, based on the number of competitors in the qualifications by gender and time schedule. This decision must be made before and will be announced at the first team captain's meeting.
